



Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) Statement

To Our Valued Customers:

K-Tube does use Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) in our production processes in the form of PTFE lubricant, primarily in our drawing process. It's important to note that while PTFE is present, it remains in trace amounts on the inner diameter surface of certain products.

To assist you in identifying whether PTFE is utilized in your specific product, we recommend referencing our [Product Number and Design Guide](#). Plug drawn parts can be identified by the presence of an 'M' or 'B' at the beginning of the part number. However, not all plug drawn parts contain PTFE. If the part number also includes a 'J', it indicates the use of an oil-based lubricant instead of PTFE.

For example:

- Part number **M058-050-I625** contains PTFE.
- Part number **MSJA058-050-H2** utilizes an oil-based lubricant instead of PTFE.
